

## 1st Masterclass: Abstract submission guidelines

- All abstracts must be submitted in English.
- PDF file shall be named as follows:

## SubmitterLastname\_SubmitterFirstname\_Country

- Per author (- group), it is allowed to submit a maximum 2 abstracts for oral presentations.
- A clear description of the design should be included
- Do not only focus on statistical results but also clinical relevance (e.g., number needed to treat or minimal clinically significant difference) and implications.
- Abstracts cannot exceed a limit of 2000 characters, including spaces (excluding title, authors and affiliations).
- All abstracts undergo an anonymous peer review process. Please do not use names of authors, institutions or countries in your abstract; otherwise, it will be rejected.
- Do not use product names or brands in your abstract; otherwise, your abstract must be rejected.
- Your abstract should be structured as follows, and each heading should be in a separate paragraph:
  - 1. Title
  - 2. Background
  - 3. Research question
  - 4. Design
  - 5. Methods
  - 6. Results
  - 7. Discussion
- Standard abbreviations do not need explanation. Otherwise, abbreviations must be defined in brackets after they are first used in the text.
- Submitting the result of one study dissipated into multiple abstracts is not recommended.
- The use of References is discouraged.
- After an abstract submission, a confirmation will be sent to the contact person's email
- Authors will be notified of the acceptance of their abstract by email by the end of March 2025
- After acceptance of your abstract, the presenting author should register for the ESUBE congress within two weeks.
